Continuing Education Fund (CEF)

The Continuing Education Fund (CEF) subsidizes adults with learning aspirations to pursue continuing education and training courses. Eligible applicants will be reimbursed up to 80% of the tuition fees, subject to a maximum sum of HK\$10,000 (whichever is the less), on successful completion of a reimbursable course. The fees for more than one reimbursable course may be reimbursed, subject to the maximum ceiling of HK\$10,000 per applicant not being exceeded.

Eligibility

Applicants/Persons who -

- are Hong Kong residents who have the right of abode or the right to land or to remain in Hong Kong without restriction, i.e. "A" (right of abode), "R" (right to land) or "U" (remain in Hong Kong without restriction) should appear below the date of birth on the HK Smart ID card. For details of the meaning of symbols, please visit the website of the Immigration Department http://www.immd.gov.hk. Holders of one-way permits from Mainland China may also apply. (A copy of the one-way permit and the HK Smart ID card should be attached to the Application Form (SFAA 192));
- have enrolled in and paid the tuition fee for a reimbursable course before the course commences; and
- are aged from 18 to 65 at the time of application and on seeking reimbursement of their fees.

Remarks:

- (1) <u>Applicants should NOT have obtained grants or means-tested loans from the Financial</u> <u>Assistance Scheme for Post-secondary Students (FASP) (「專上學生資助計劃」)</u>, administered by the Student Financial Assistance Agency (SFAA) for the same course.
- (2) <u>Applicants who have obtained loans from Non-means-tested Loan Scheme (「免入息審査</u> <u>計劃」</u>), administered by the Student Financial Assistance Agency (SFAA), <u>can still apply for</u> <u>CEF</u>. This loan is not a subsidized loan.

Application Procedures

- Complete the application form "SFAA 192 (2012)", which can be obtained from the College General Office at NAB312, District Offices, OCEF and website of OCEF at <u>http://www.sfaa.gov.hk/cef/forms.htm</u>.
- Carefully read the "Guidance Notes for Application" [SFAA 191 (2012)] before completing the Application Form.
- Before submission to the OCEF, <u>the application form should be certified and stamped at</u> <u>the College General Office at NAB312</u>.
- The completed application form should be submitted in person or by post together with photocopies of HKID card and, the one-way permit (if applicable) to the OCEF before the commencement date of the reimbursable course.
- Late applications will not be accepted by the OCEF.

Reimbursement Procedures

- Each successful applicant will be provided with a <u>Reimbursement Claim Form (SFAA 193)</u> (<u>RCF</u>) from OCEF, which should be submitted after successful completion of the course(s) and, in any event, within 4 years from the date the application was approved.
- Claimants should print his/her unofficial transcript out from myPortal which shows the completion of the reimbursable course(s) that he/she applies for.
- Claimants should submit the RCF and the unofficial transcript to the College General Office at NAB312 for verification.
- Claimants will be informed to obtain a Letter of Certificate to prove his/her successful completion of the course(s) within a week.
- Claimants should submit the completed and certified RCF together with copies of supporting documents (viz. Letter of Certificate, tuition fee receipts, and the front page of his/her bank passbook/statement showing the name, account number, and bank name/bank code) to the OCEF in person or by post.

Remarks:

- (1) The claimants must have attended no less than 70% of the contactable hours of the course or such higher attendance requirement as prescribed for the course (whichever is higher) and attained the overall passing mark for the course to meet the fee reimbursement criteria.
- (2) Claimants studying language courses are additionally required to pass a specified benchmark test at the specified (or higher) level after the course has commenced and before the expiry of the 4-year validity period. For example, claimants can apply for reimbursement from LCC005 and LCC006 courses if they pass the PSC Test (普通話水平測試) from the State Language Commission (國家語言文字工作委員會) between local tertiary education institutions for Chinese courses.
- (3) In general, payment will be made within 6 weeks from the date of receipt of the RCF, subject to complete and satisfactory supporting documents being provided.
- (4) The Reimbursement Claim Form (SFAA193) and the Reimbursement Claim Form for Benchmark Test / Examination Fees (SFAA 205) are controlled forms, and the forms are sent to all successful applicants together with Approval in-principle Letter. These forms are not available for download. Applicants who have lost their RCFs should inform the OCEF and request for a replacement copy in person, by post, via email cef@sfaa.gov.hk, or via enquiry hotline 3142 2277.
